Peace Be with You!

In our gospel passage on this Sunday, Jesus speaks of peace 'three times' to his fearful disciples. 'Peace be with you', he told them. When we hear the word 'peace', we often think of it as the absence of war or conflict, but the meaning of shalom (the Hebrew word for peace) denotes the presence of something instead of an absence. To offer someone peace in Jesus's time meant to wish him/her a completeness and fulness of life. Earlier in John's gospel Jesus proclaims that he has come that we 'might have life and have it more abundantly' (Jn 10). Despite the locks the disciples had placed upon the door, Jesus enters the room in which they are barricaded and says to them, 'Peace be with you'. Their fear cannot keep him away. Once again, he stands before them, offers them abundant life.

Perhaps it is something in the human condition that we do not automatically believe good news, or news that might seem too good to be true. But in the week of Easter, we learn that God wants to surprise us with joy. He wants us to live in the life of the resurrection. Rather, than be sceptics, he wants us to be joyful in the knowledge that his love is greater than even death. Of course, we all know that it is hard to keep up the flame of faith and hope when misfortunes befall us, when persecutions arise or the search for reason and facts become futile. Like the apostles, we too are reluctant to accept the risen Lord. Often, we fail Christ in life, but today's Gospel assures us of the 'gift of peace' and shouldn't allow our past to crush us, but rise above it, and humbly accepting God's gracious gift of peace.
