## Ending Lenten's Season

Holy Week is the most sacred time of our Church's year, in which we remember the great events which reveal that God so loved the world that he send his Son to be our Saviour. Our Saviour offers healing to the sick and suffering; forgiveness to those who confess their sins and paradise to those who pray. Jesus presents a portrait of how we are to live and build a community of disciples who are the Church. This life of community is characterised by healing words and actions, forgiveness and trusting in the good of other people. Holy Week invites us to journey with Christ in the events of the Passion so that after Calvary we may come to live in the hope of resurrection.

## Holy Week programme

**Holy Thursday 18/04/19-** Holy Mass at 7:30pm. During this Mass the feet of 12 persons (symbol of 12 Apostles) will be wash - Please volunteer to be one of them. The Eucharistic Ministers will renew their commitment to serve.

**Good Friday 19/04/19** our **Stations of the Cross** will be at 2:00 pm. Starts inside church and have a short walk to the Calvary where we shall conclude the stations. **At 3:00pm** we shall gather together again to celebrate the Passion of the Lord, Venerate the Cross and receive the Holy Eucharist.

**Holy Saturday 20/04/19** - Easter Vigil Mass at 8:00pm. Starting with the blessing of the fire and lighting of the Paschal Candle, to be followed by the official reception of new members to the faith.

**Easter Sunday 21/04/19:** Masses as normal Sunday 9:00am and 11:15am.
