St. Peter and St. Paul

Have you noticed that away from the Church we hear more about St Peter than we do about St Paul? It is because St Peter regularly features in jokes about heaven, like this one: A man dies and meets St Peter at the gates of heaven. St Peter says "before you meet with God, I thought I shall tell you that we have looked at your life, and you really didn't do anything particularly good or bad. We were not at all sure what to do with you. Can you tell us anything you did that can help us decide? The newly arrived soul thought a moment and replied, "yah, once I was driving along and came upon a woman who was being harassed by a group of bikers, so I pulled over, got out my tire iron, and went up to the leader of the gang. He was a big, muscular, hairy guy with tattoos all over his body and a ring pierced through his nose. Well, I told him he and his gang had better stop bothering the woman or they would have to deal with me!" "I am impressed", St Peter responded. "But when did this happen?" Less than ten minutes ago, the newly arrived soul replied. St Paul doesn't feature in many funny stories except for the children who got rather confused about his life and wrote in their exam's paper that "St Paul Cavorted to Christianity. He preached holy acrimony, which is another name for marriage. St Peter and St Paul are spiritual giants in our faith. Together they continued the work of Jesus in establishing his Church throughout the Eastern Mediterranean. The successor of St Peter continues to lead and shape our Catholic Church whereas the epistles of St Paul form nearly one quarter of the New Testament. And yet both Peter and Paul, were also sinners. Today on their feast day, let us not only stand back in awe at the good work they were able to accomplish, but let us also rejoice in the God who works with sinful humanity to bring life to the world.
