7th July 2019: 14th Sunday Yr. C Parish Mass Book - Readings on page 48 Messengers of Peace

When Christ came into the world, angels sang about peace; and when he went out of the world, peace was bequeathed. *"Whatever house you go into," he instructed his disciples when sending them on missions, "let your first words be, 'Peace be to this house!'" Luke 10:5.* It was the same peace which Isaiah foretold as coming in abundance: *"towards her I send peace flowing like a river" Isaiah 66:12.* What precious gift of God to humankind is this peace. It is the will of God for us that in the world's most crowded streets, Cities, and indeed in the entire globe, humanity should enjoy the peace of Christ in the depth of their heart.

The peace of Christ begins in one's heart, but it is meant to flow into the hearts of others, so that the personal peace becomes world peace. Blessed are the peacemakers, they shall never be unemployed, for there is so much need for the peace of Christ in today's world. As Jesus, in this Sunday's gospel sent out his disciples to pass on this peace to others, he complained that, *"the harvest is rich, but the labourers are few, Luke 10:2,"* thus indirectly urging all of his would-be followers to become messengers of peace.

There are many ways by which we can bring the peace of Christ to others. This unusual story is one way – a man who returned to his car which was parked outside a large shopping centre. Lying on the front seat was a note: *"Dear Sir/Madam: I fully intended to steal your car until I noticed the 'Peace-Be-To-You' sticker. It made me pause and reflect. I responded that if I did steal your car, you certainly would not be at peace and on the other hand, I felt I would not be at peace either, as this was my 'first job'! So, peace be to you and to me. Drive carefully and next time lock your car."*

The note was signed: *"A Would-Be Car Thief."*
