Prayer of intercession

Around fifty years after the death of Jesus, the Gospel of Luke was most probably written for the Christian community in Antioch, which was the political and cultural capital of the Roman Province of Syria. There are six major themes running throughout this gospel: *prayer, hospitality, compassion, forgiveness, the common life and care for outsider*. Most of them expressed in the thirty-eight words of our Father. Perseverance in prayer and the simplicity of deep faith also characterises this gospel. We declare that we belong to God in the most intimate of ways as members of God's family and therefore, we belong to each other. We pray that God's Kingdom will come here and now, through our gratitude for God's generosity and forgiveness and so that we can be saved from evil. This Sunday's passage of the gospel of Luke, is dedicated to the Lord's prayer – our Father. Jesus says - when you pray say: *'Father, hallowed be your name...'* when we pray- *'Thy will be done'* we are making our own Christ's most intimate prayer, the prayer that motivated his entire life. The Lord's prayer, with its request for daily bread and forgiveness, is the best possible **"table prayer"** for the banquet of the Lord at the Holy Mass. A child needs a father and a mother who really care. It is very difficult to live and mature without parents. Unfortunately, it sometimes happens that human fathers and mothers disappoint their little ones and let them down in one way or another. But Jesus tells us that there is one Father who never lets us down, who can always be counted on. We have a Father who is good, who is love in person, a Father who knows each of us by name, who cares, who is always for us, who is gracious and forgiving. Above all, a Father who is lavish – his love for us never gives up on us, who believes in us.
