Transfiguration

This feast is the feast of encouragement for Christians. *One day the devil decided to put a few of his well-worn tools up for sale. On display were some treacherous instruments including hatred, jealousy, lying and pride. Set apart from the rest, however, was a harmless looking device with a very high price tag. "What is that?" someone asked. "That is discouragement", Satan replied, "it is one of my most effective tools; with it, I pry open the hearts of God's greatest servants and bring on depression."* Hence, when we are in trouble, we must take care not to fall into the devil's snare. We are encouraged by the Lord's transfiguration to be patient amid troubles, for it radiates hope in the ultimate victory of the good. *"Listen to my beloved Son"*, says the heavenly Father.

The Coronavirus: Parish Advice
