On this day the Church recalls the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem to accomplish his paschal mystery.



Holy Thursday 17th April 2025

Mass of the Lord's Supper - 7:30p.m

The Easter Triduum: the three days that begin on Holy Thursday with the Mass of the Lord's Supper, celebrates the Paschal event,

and that newness of life which flows from the crucified, buried, and risen Christ. At this Mass the Lord also commissioned us to serve.

On this day and the following day, by a most ancient tradition, the Church does not celebrate the sacraments at all, except Penance & Anointing of the sick. At Three O'clock, the celebration of the Lord's Passion takes place.

Holy Saturday 19th April 2025 Easter Vigil 7:30 p.m.

This is the most Sacred Night, mother of all vigils, in which our Lord Jesus Christ passed over from death to life, and the Church calls upon all her sons and daughters to come together to watch and pray. New members
