Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity Sunday Year A

Readings: *Exodus 34:4b-6; Dan 3; 2 Corinthians.13:11-14; John 3:16-18*



Bind us together in Love, O Lord

Father was driving his little son in a car. Suddenly, the son turned towards his father and asked him, "Dad! Is God – one or many?" "One, my son." Came the reply from the father. "Is the Father, God?" the boy went on, "Yes." His father replied. "Is Jesus God?" "Yes." "Is the Holy Spirit – God?" "Yes." His father responded. "Then how can Jesus be his own Dad?" His father thought quickly. He drove the car to the side of the road and stop. He then turned towards his son and said, "You see the bonnet in the front of this car. Inside the bonnet there is battery. There is only one battery. Yet I can start the car with it, turn on the lights and also blow the horn. How this happens, I don't know. It is a mystery to me. Likewise, God is one, but three Persons – the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a mystery, and we cannot fully understand".

The Trinity is one of the topics, which is very difficult for any Christian to easily understand. It deals with the mystery of God. God is essentially incomprehensible. But God in his goodness has revealed himself progressively in the Bible. Through the revelation in the Bible, God has revealed to us that he is a Trinity of persons. God is one, but he is in Three Persons – the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. There are indications in the Old Testament about the Trinity, but the full revelation of the Trinity came to us through our Lord Jesus Christ in the New Testament.

All the Three Persons of the Blessed Trinity are equal. Often, there have been wrong views about the Trinity. The heresy of Arius in A.D 260 was that Jesus Christ, the Son, was created by God the Father and thus he is not God. Arius denied the Divinity of Christ. The Father, Son, Holy Spirit – Three in One Substance.

The Father, Son and Holy Spirit, dwell in a loving relationship. God is a loving family. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit dwell in a loving community. Their love must be a pattern for us to build our family and our community. "The Christian family is a communion of persons, a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit". (Catechism of Catholic Church, no 2205).

Praying for the protection and unity of the disciples, in his priestly prayer, Jesus prayed thus: "Holy Father, protect them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one, as we are one (Jn 17:11b)" and further he prayed for all the future Christian thus, "I ask not only on behalf of these, but also on behalf of those who will believe in me through their word" (Jh17:20).

May this prayer of Jesus bind us together as children of God – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.
