Corpus Christi Procession today 7th June.

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Readings: *Deuteronomy 8:2-3; Psalm 147; 1 Cor..10:16-17; John 6:51-58*



People of the Eucharistic; the Body & Blood of Christ.

Eucharistic people are people who believe in the real presence of Christ in the eucharist. They are spirit-filled people, because the reception of the eucharist is a communion with the very life of Jesus for he said, *"I myself am the living bread"* (Jn6:51).

In the eucharist Jesus nourishes our spirits not only for this life but for eternal life also. It is with the eucharist we become fully alive in our life of the spirit.

Eucharistic people are contended people. According to an Indian fable, Lord Vishnu said once to his devotee: *"I am weary of your never-ending petitions. I shall grant you three requests. Make sure you choose them carefully because having granted them, I shall grant you nothing more."* The elated devotee did not hesitate. *"Here is my request,"* first he said, *"I want my wife to die so I can marry a better woman."* His wish was immediately granted. But when friends and relatives gathered for the funeral and began to recall the virtues of his wife, the devotee saw he had been hasty. So, he asked the Lord to bring her back to life. That left him with just one more petition. He consulted widely. Some advised him to ask for immortality, others advised him to seek for a good health, others for money and wealth, and many more advice. The devotee was so confused that he finally asked the Lord himself: *"Tell me what to ask for."* The Lord laughed and said, *"Ask to be content, no matter what you get."* Of course, we can never be contended by bread alone, nor by richness, but by every Word that comes from God. Fortunately for eucharistic people, they believe in the Lord God who is the source of contentment and who is present in the eucharist.

Eucharistic people are united people. Eucharist unite them into one body of Christ. *"We, though many ... are one body..."* (1Cor 10:17). *"If then,"* says St Augustine, *"you are the body of Christ and its members, it is your own mystery which is placed on the Lord's table; it is your own mystery which you receive. It is to what you are that you answer Amen and in so responding subscribe to it. Be member of the body of Christ so that your Amen will be true."*

Eucharistic people are community people. The eucharist creates unity and hence communion means community. Husbands and wives who receive communion pledge themselves anew not only to Christ but to each other.

Single people, and individually gifted persons who share in eucharist commit themselves to share in the destiny of their brothers and sisters in Christ. *"Is not the cup of blessing we bless a sharing in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread we break a sharing in the body of Christ?"* (1Cor 10:16).

Eucharistic people are caring people. To receive communion is to receive others into our world of concern. There is something in our relationship with the Lord in the eucharist if our communion does not bring us into a caring relationship with others.
